WHY IMPACT?

The IPCC (Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change) has identified three major potential future effects of climate change:

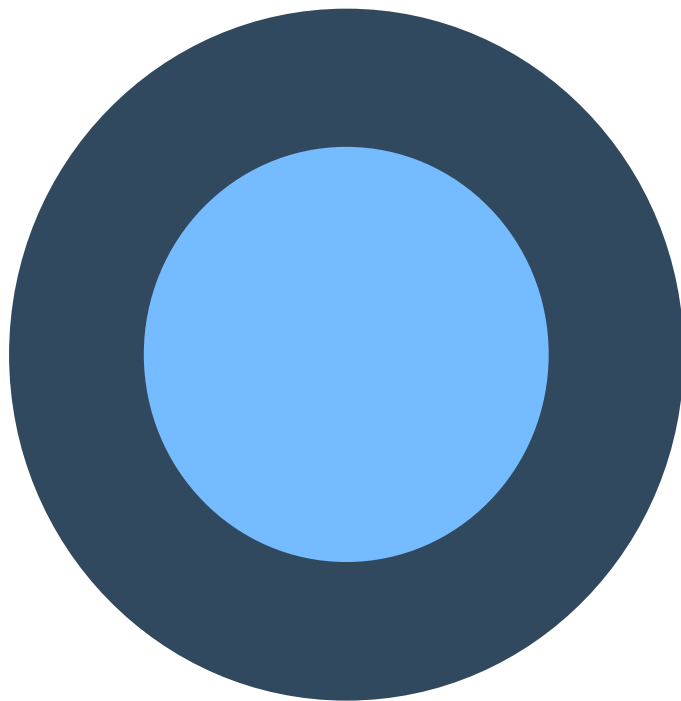

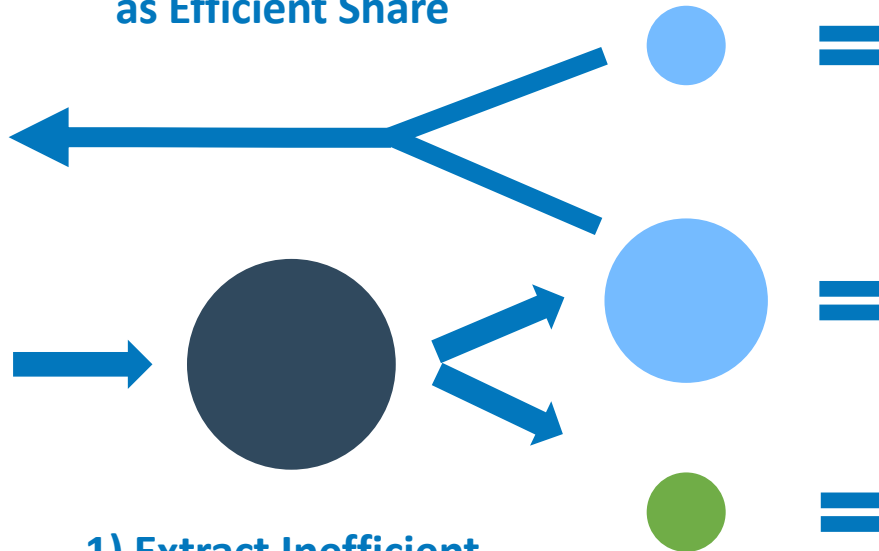
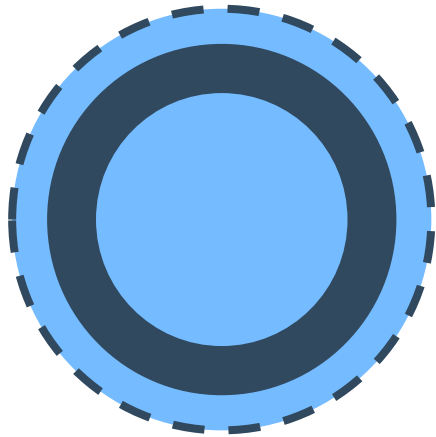
Efficient Market Share

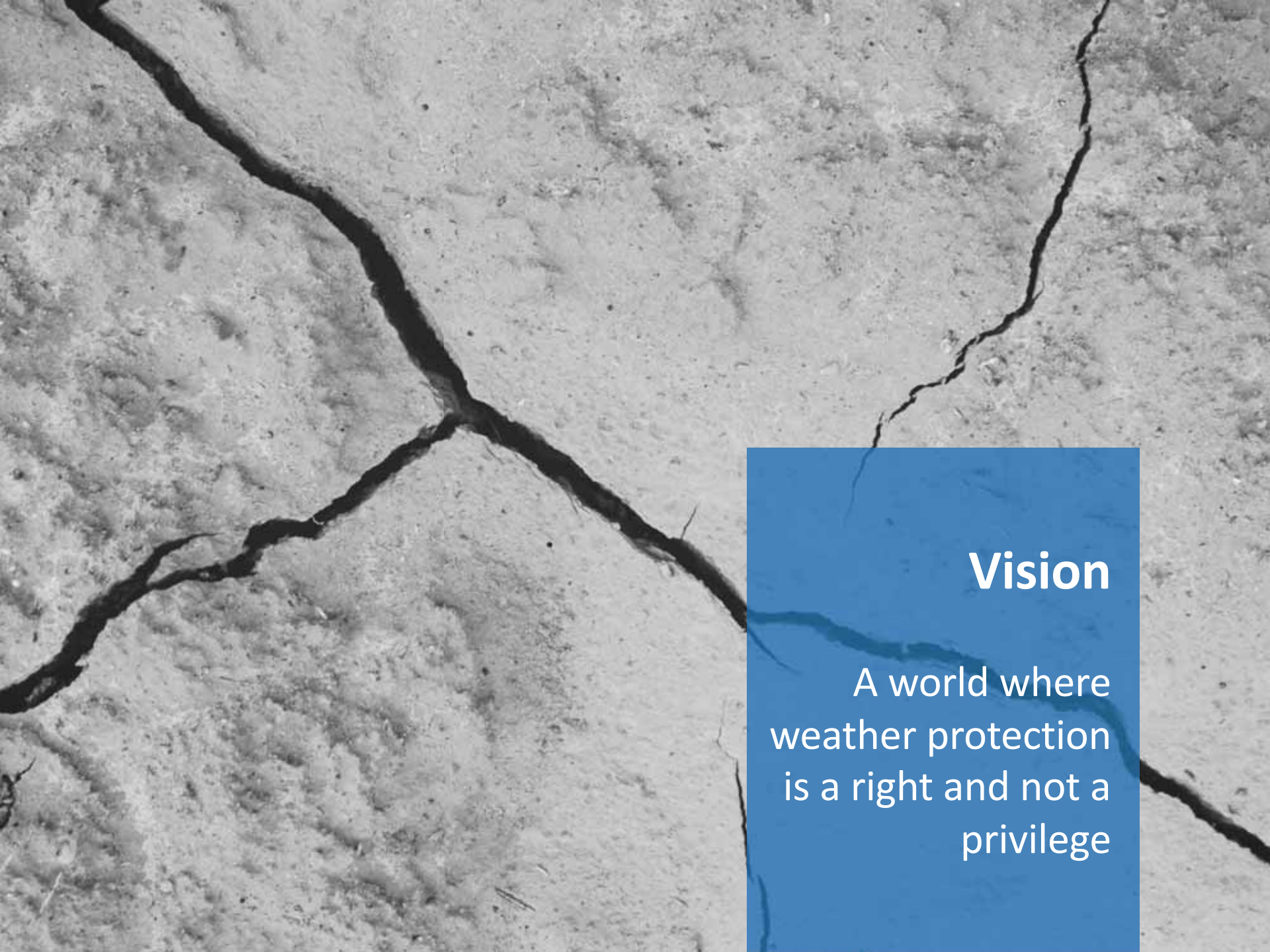
